What is Narcan

Narcan (Naloxone) is a medication that is effective in reversing the effects of an opioid overdose in an individual.

Learning Objectives

- Learn how to recognize and effectively respond to an opioid overdose
- Learn what Naloxone is, how to store it, and how to administer it
- Learn about relevant laws and legislation around Naloxone, including the statewide standing order

Upon completion of the training, you are eligible to receive a free Opioid Rescue Kit.

Trainings We Offer

Classroom-style training: This is the most informative style of training for any member of the public. The training offers an informative presentation to a small group in 30-45 minutes with plenty of time for questions and answers.

POD (Point of Distribution) -style training: Best for returning trainees, or those who have used their naloxone kit previously. This training only requires a few minutes per person.
